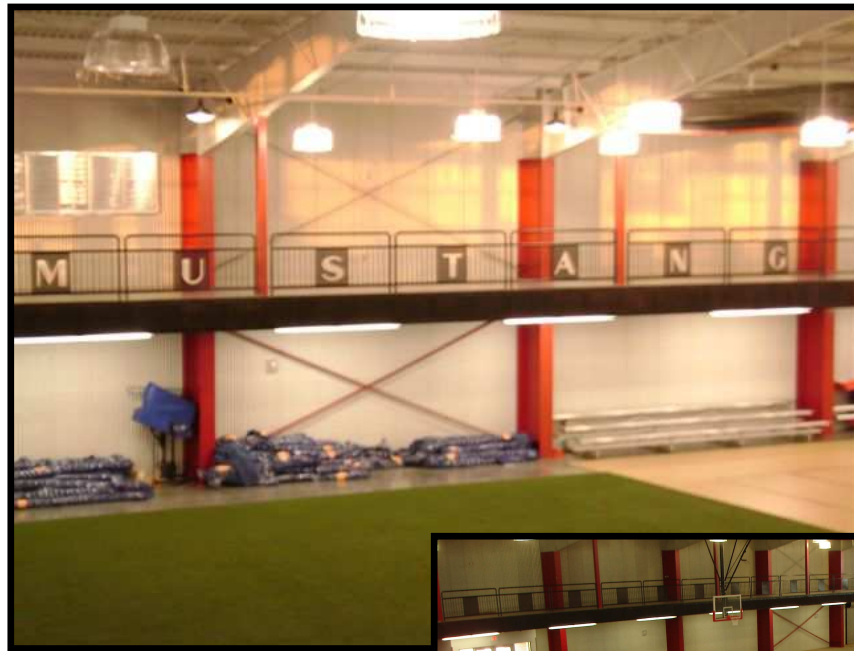

- Fall 2008- Mr. Jim Burke, formally Director of Building and Grounds made the initial recommendation to the school district relying heavily on Vector's website. From his research it was determined that Taraflex would be the product of choice and was communicated back to the architectural firm.
- **NOTE: Since this time Mr. Burke has left his position with Mustang ISD and now serves as the CFO for neighboring OKC City Schools. From a recent visit by both the school district and Sudexo we have just submitted a proposal for a single project in excess of \$ 250,000.**
- Steve got involved shortly after he joined Vector Concepts through a phone call from Mike Clark the District AD voicing his concern over the product selected and him not being familiar with Taraflex. Not wasting any time and with no local installations to use as a reference, Steve took Mike to Tulsa for a day of site visits and at the end of the day he agreed the district had made a good choice and felt that Taraflex was well suited for their needs and application. What was originally to be two gym floors they expanded its use to include the workout area for the cheerleaders, aerobic area, weight room for stationary machines in addition to a suspended four lane walk/jog track.



- In addition, through their open door policy we have had many visits to their facility by potential customers, both neighboring school systems and architects. From a recent visit Steve was successful in switching a project from the base bid specified product, Mondo to Taraflex by issuing Vector Concepts a change order.
- As a result of this installation and its acceptance and ultimate performance the school district has graciously opened their facility to anyone who would like to see Taraflex in action. Since then, the school district has approximately \$ 300,000 dollars worth of projects with the funds pending using both Taraflex and Vector Concepts.





This is what Jeff Woodard, Director Bond Projects/ Construction Mustang Public Schools had to say, “The Gerflor multipurpose floor has been installed in Mustang Public School Health and Wellness center for 4 months. It is used for all activities from PE to basketball 6 – 8 hours per day. Student athletes have made comments on how they really like the “feel” of the floor during basketball practices. No slip or sliding during the activities. Very clean look and cosmetically appealing.

Maintenance of the floor is relatively simple and easy. No more refinishing maple wood courts or waxing the tile floors. This floor has the potential of being very maintenance friendly. Daily micro fiber dry mop and weekly floor scrubber use has been MPS routine maintenance.

The Gerflor multipurpose floor is one of a kind in that it looks like a wood floor but does not require the maintenance associated with one.
